	<p>Kelani Raja Maha Vihara, Peliyagoda</p> <p>The temple is 10km from Colombo & an important site of Buddhist pilgrimage in the Island. Every January there is a religious pageant with traditional dancers & elephants in bright regalia.</p>	Day 1 at 8 am
	<p>Pettah Market, Colombo 11</p> <p>Laid out on the suburb of Pettah in the city of Colombo and more precisely on Market Street, the Pettah Market is famous as one of the busiest open marketplaces in the country's western urban region.</p>	Day 1 at 10 am
	<p>The Dutch Hospital, Colombo 1</p> <p>History of the Dutch Hospital in Colombo dates back over three centuries and today, with its open courtyards, restaurants and souvenir shops, is the perfect venue to relax and unwind in Colombo.</p>	Day 1 at 11 am
	<p>Old Parliament, Colombo 1</p> <p>The building of the Old Parliament is still preserved to this day in its entire Neo-Baroque splendor as it sits in the Colombo Fort region. The entrance area itself resembles an old Greek temple.</p>	Day 1 at 1 pm
	<p>Galle Face Green, Colombo 1</p> <p>The iconic Galle Face Green once covered a massive area, even larger than what it is now, with one end bounded by the Beira Lake and the other lying on the boundary of the Galle Face Hotel.</p>	Day 1 at 1 pm
	<p>Viharamahadevi Park, Colombo 7</p> <p>Located in the heart of Colombo opposite the Town Hall, Viharamahadevi Park is an oasis of greenery amongst the concrete jungle of the capital. Its gardens are dominated by groves of large shady trees</p>	Day 1 at 2 pm

	<p>Town Hall, Colombo 7</p> <p>One of the most iconic landmarks in the city of Colombo is the Colombo Town Hall. It is the center of the Colombo Municipal Council and the associated municipal offices.</p>	<p>Day 1 at 2 pm</p>
	<p>The National Museum, Colombo 7</p> <p>Situated within the heart of a leafy, residential area in Colombo, the National Museum is housed in a sprawling white, colonial style building lying surrounded by vast expanses of manicured lawns.</p>	<p>Day 1 at 3 pm</p>
	<p>Independence Square, Colombo 7</p> <p>Independence Square, a famous landmark of Colombo built in 1948, to commemorate the country's freedom from the British colonizers. It draws direct inspiration from the Kandyan monument, Magul Maduwa.</p>	<p>Day 1 at 4 pm</p>
	<p>BMICH, Colombo 7</p> <p>The BMICH is an instantly recognizable facet of Colombo, and among the very first purpose-built convention centers in Asia itself.</p>	<p>Day 1 at 5 pm</p>
	<p>Mt. Lavinia Beach, Mt Lavinia</p> <p>Mt. Lavinia beach, lies within the southern suburban area of Colombo and is the place to go to if your looking for sun and surf in the city.</p>	<p>Day 1 at 6 pm</p>
