	<p>Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage , Pinnawala</p> <p>The Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage is one of the best places to see large numbers of elephants in a controlled environment. Pinnawala is best visited at feeding & bathing times which happens twice a day</p>	Day 1 at 9 am
	<p>Gadaladeniya Temple, Peradeniya</p> <p>One of the masterpieces of the Gampola Kingdom of the late Medieval to the Renaissance eras, it was actually named Gadaladeniya due to the village in which the monastery was built.</p>	Day 1 at 11 am
	<p>Udawatta Kele Sanctuary, Kandy</p> <p>Lying in the heart of the busy hill capital of Kandy, Udawatte Kelle Sanctuary encompasses the forested hill slopes behind the sacred Temple of the Tooth. The history of this forested area dates back</p>	Day 1 at 2 pm
	<p>Temple Of The Sacred Tooth Relic, Kandy</p> <p>The Temple of the Tooth or Dalada Maligawa houses the tooth relic of Lord Buddha and is one of the most sacred sites of Buddhist pilgrimage. The temple is within Sri Lanka's last royal palace complex</p>	Day 1 at 4 pm
	<p>Kandy National Museum, Kandy</p> <p>Situated next to the Temple of the Tooth, the museum features exhibits from the Kandyan & post-British colonial period. Artifacts include royal relics, thrones, scepters, ceremonial swords & jewellery.</p>	Day 1 at 4 pm
	<p>Ramboda Falls, Nuwara Eliya</p> <p>Lying midway between Kandy and Nuwara Eliya just outside Pussellawa, amidst scenic tea gardens, Ramboda Falls is 357-feet high and easily seen from the main road. The country's eleventh highest</p>	Day 2 at 9 am

	<p>Nuwara Eliya, Nuwara Eliya</p> <p>Perched at an elevation of 6,000ft, Nuwara Eliya lies at the heart of Sri Lanka's tea country, from where prized Ceylon tea originates. Established during British colonial times by pioneering...</p>	<p>Day 2 at 10 am</p>
	<p>Lake Gregory, Nuwara Eliya</p> <p>Enjoy the picturesque Lake Gregory, one of many beautiful places in Nuwara Eliya. Recreational activities include boat tours, walking path tours, bicycle rides and pony rides.</p>	<p>Day 2 at 11 am</p>
	<p>Seetha Amman Temple, Hakgala</p> <p>The temple, surrounded by the wonderful misty cloud forests of N'Elia, is the only place of worship dedicated to Lady Sita, the chaste wife of Lord Rama and one of the primary protagonists of Ramayana.</p>	<p>Day 2 at 2 pm</p>
	<p>Hakgala Gardens, Hakgala</p> <p>A speciality of the gardens is its emphasis on temperate species, beautifully laid out over its terraced slopes. The gardens feature a large rose garden, with its myriad of colourful blooms perfuming</p>	<p>Day 2 at 3 pm</p>
	<p>Ella, Ella</p> <p>Situated on the southern cusp of Sri Lanka's hill country, Ella is a quiet, picturesque and almost non-touristy retreat lying amidst rolling green hills of tea. Its 3,000ft elevation provides a very</p>	<p>Day 3 at 8 am</p>
	<p>Rawana Falls, Ella</p> <p>One of the country's broadest. Seen from the Ella-Wellawaya road, the falls seem to spring from nothing halfway up a granite cliff-face but are actually fed by a natural cave system. The falls</p>	<p>Day 3 at 9 am</p>
	<p>Dowa Cave Temple, Ella</p> <p>The temple of Dowa dates back to the 1st Century BC, to the era of Valagamba of Anuradhapura and lies on the Badulla-Bandarawela Road. The temple's claim to fame is a massive Buddha image, flattened</p>	<p>Day 3 at 11 am</p>
	<p>Yala National Park, Yala</p> <p>Lying within the South-Eastern dry zone, the Yala National Park is the most popular destination for game watching in Sri Lanka. Its landscape and topography ranges from dense scrub jungle, to open</p>	<p>Day 4 at 9 am</p>
