




	<p><b>Kitulgala, Kitulgala</b></p> <p>Sri Lanka's second longest river, the Kelani, forms a natural choke point before widening out again, making it the most popular location for whitewater rafting in the country.</p>	Day 1 at 9 am
	<p><b>St. Clair Falls, Thalawakelle</b></p> <p>St. Clair's Falls is one of Sri Lanka's most scenic, located on the Hatton-Nuwara Eliya road, a short distance away from Talawakele. At a height of 262ft it is the country's 20th tallest.</p>	Day 1 at 12 pm
	<p><b>Devon Falls, Thalawakelle</b></p> <p>This spectacular 318ft waterfall is off the Hatton-Nuwara Eliya road, near Talawakele. It's the country's 19th tallest &amp; lies on the Kotmale Oya (river), a tributary of Mahaweli, SL's longest river</p>	Day 1 at 12 pm
	<p><b>Nuwara Eliya, Nuwara Eliya</b></p> <p>Perched at an elevation of 6,000ft, Nuwara Eliya lies at the heart of Sri Lanka's tea country, from where prized Ceylon tea originates. Established during British colonial times by pioneering...</p>	Day 1 at 2 pm
	<p><b>Seetha Amman Temple, Hakgala</b></p> <p>The temple, surrounded by the wonderful misty cloud forests of N'Eliya, is the only place of worship dedicated to Lady Sita, the chaste wife of Lord Rama and one of the primary protagonists of Ramayana.</p>	Day 1 at 3 pm
	<p><b>Lake Gregory, Nuwara Eliya</b></p> <p>Enjoy the picturesque Lake Gregory, one of many beautiful places in Nuwara Eliya. Recreational activities include boat tours, walking path tours, bicycle rides and pony rides.</p>	Day 1 at 4 pm

	<p>Ramboda Falls, <b>Nuwara Eliya</b></p> <p>Lying midway between Kandy and Nuwara Eliya just outside Pussellawa, amidst scenic tea gardens, Ramboda Falls is 357-feet high and easily seen from the main road. The country's eleventh highest</p>	<p>Day 2 at 8 am</p>
	<p>Temple Of The Sacred Tooth Relic, <b>Kandy</b></p> <p>The Temple of the Tooth or Dalada Maligawa houses the tooth relic of Lord Buddha and is one of the most sacred sites of Buddhist pilgrimage. The temple is within Sri Lanka's last royal palace complex</p>	<p>Day 2 at 10 am</p>
	<p>Royal Botanic Gardens, <b>Peradeniya</b></p> <p>Stroll through 140 acres of meticulously landscaped gardens with over 4,000 species of flora. Interesting highlights-the spectacular Javan fig tree, the double coconut palm &amp; the curios canon ball tree</p>	<p>Day 2 at 2 pm</p>
	<p>Polonnaruwa Ancient City, <b>Polonnaruwa</b></p> <p>For a glimpse of medieval Sri Lankan architecture and craftsmanship, no better example exists than the ancient city of Polonnaruwa, a World Heritage site. Towards the end of the first millennia</p>	<p>Day 3 at 10 am</p>
	<p>Minneriya National Park, <b>Minneriya</b></p> <p>A relatively small park of scrubland and dry zone forest, its focal point is the ancient Minneriya Tank, which becomes the site for one of the greatest natural spectacles in the world.</p>	<p>Day 3 at 3 pm</p>
	<p>Sigiriya Rock Fortress, <b>Sigiriya</b></p> <p>Sigiriya or the Lion Rock is Sri Lanka's single most visited tourist attraction and with good reason. With its history lying in family feud and patricide, this lone sentinel of reddish gneiss rising</p>	<p>Day 4 at 9 am</p>
	<p>Dambulla Golden Temple, <b>Dambulla</b></p> <p>A complex of five caves, lying ensconced within a 600-foot rock massif rising from the plains, the history of the Golden Temple of Dambulla dates back to the 1st Century BC. This cave complex</p>	<p>Day 4 at 2 pm</p>
	<p>Aukana Buddha Statue, <b>Habarana</b></p> <p>Carved out of a solid rock face, the statue is one of the finest examples of rock sculpture in the country, and is created in the Asisa Mudra, or Posture of Blessing, which is a variation of the</p>	<p>Day 5 at 9 am</p>
